A motion was heard in the above-noted matter via Zoom videoconference today.

The only counsel in attendance was Fleming, M., for the Receiver.

## **Endorsement**

The Receiver RSM Canada Limited brings this motion for, among other relief, authorization to make certain payments (e.g., CRA, WEPPA), and distributions to the Applicant, approval of the Receiver's Third Report and its activities described therein, approval of the Receiver's Interim Statement of Receipts and Disbursements, approval of the fees of the Receiver and its counsel; and termination of the proceedings and a discharge of the Receiver.

All persons on the service list were duly served. The motion is unopposed.

I have reviewed the Receiver's Third Report, including the Receiver's Statement of Receipts and Disbursements for the period July 26, 2018 to December 9, 2020, which appears to be in order.
